“Whilst there has been an increasing amount of promise and hype around the use of solar powered aircraft and airships to fly “forever” in the stratosphere, the only successful programme to date - Zephyr - was designed, built and continues in Farnborough, UK. Paul Brooks founded the Zephyr programme alongside Zephyr’s designer, Chris Kelleher, in 2003 and the 14 day flight of Zephyr 7 in 2010 remains after 7 years not only a World record, but the only solar aircraft to have flown at altitude for more than 1 day and night. The talk will outline the technical challenges associated with high altitude, long endurance (HALE) flight, quantify the benefits that such aircraft can provide and indicate how to separate the hype from the reality.”
